If eligible for licensure as a Psychologist or Psychological Associate, the applicant must **already** qualify for either a certificate authorizing autonomous / interim autonomous practice, or a certificate authorizing supervised practice with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Please refer to the College of Psychologists of Ontario if you are unsure as to whether you qualify for such a certificate.

Post qualification experience is an asset in working in a community setting across the age span and with diverse clinical presentations.

Knowledge and experience of working in a range of treatment modalities.

A proven ability to provide culturally sensitive services to clients of all ages, backgrounds and identities.

Be able to work responsibly and independently in a fast-paced, growing practice.

Additional to holding a Master's or Ph.D., ideally have post qualification experience, training or certification in a recognised and empirically validated treatment modality.
